

While neither Rex Childcare nor public health authorities will identify any individuals, who have tested positive for the virus or provide information that may compromise confidentiality in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), rest assured that we have and continue to take the following additional measures to help flatten the curve:

- Enhanced Sanitization Efforts in addition to weekly professional deep cleans, and the around-the-clock sanitizations, we will utilize a professional cleaner who sprays the building to provide a more thorough, consistent, and complete approach to applying sanitizing chemicals. There will also be several additional sanitization supplies in and around our center, classrooms, and amenities for your convenience.
- Social Distancing Adherence our staff members and students remain 6-feet away from all persons at all times as recommended by the CDC. We provide **designated standing spots** and ask that all adhere to any other visual cues or flyers found throughout our community; generally, do your best to keep a 6-foot distance at all times.
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) each staff member and students utilizes a face covering at all times. We politely ask and require that all guests wear a face covering while visiting our center or any common area space within the property dropping off and picking up students.
- No Contact Tours and Interactions No tours or Parents allowed in at this time so as to take safety precautions while allowing for no hand-to-hand transactions. New plexiglass germ shields are present and are designed to provide a protective barrier between guests and staff members for the safety of all involved. Currently a sign-in team is set-up outside to facilitate easy sign-in/sign-out at drop-off and pickup.
- Communication as we have for the duration of this global situation, we commit to continuing our open and frequent lines of communication. As need-to-know information arises, it will always be passed along.

The most important thing for us all to do is to work together to flatten the curve. Remember the following:

- Avoid contact with persons who are sick;
- · Practice social distancing of at least six feet;
- · Frequently clean hands with soap and water or alcohol-based sanitizer;
- Wear your mask while you are out in the public or around unknown individuals;
- Cover your cough and sneezes (into your flexed elbow or tissue) and wash your hands immediately; and
